#### CSUN Follow-Up Groups: Descriptions

<u>Success Stories</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as Freshmen or Transfers who graduated from CSUN with Bachelor's degrees only.

<u>Problem Children</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as Freshmen or Transfers who dropped out of CSUN and did *not* complete degrees elsewhere.

<u>Stars</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as Freshmen or Transfers, completed Bachelor's degrees at CSUN *or* elsewhere, *and* completed a Graduate degree elsewhere.

<u>Other People's Children</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as Freshmen or Transfers, left CSUN before completing a degree, and earned Bachelor's degrees elsewhere.

<u>Graduate Completers</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as post-Bachelor's students and completed a Graduate degree at CSUN.

<u>Graduate Drops</u>: Students who entered CSUN in 1995-2005 as post-Bachelor's students and did *not* complete a Graduate degree at CSUN.


